
## **Solid-Core Pan**

with reinforced bottom



- 1 Check shower pocket area for level and for correct dimensions. Make sure drain hole in floor is in the correct position.
- **2 DRY-FIT THE PAN:** Set pan in the pocket. You **MUST** use a level to ensure pan is level. Shim if necessary.



- 3 Remove pan from the framing pocket. Have a plumber install drain fitting in pan (see Steps 7–9). Plumber should also prepare drain pipe to receive the drain.
  - To avoid deforming the pan, once drain fitting is installed DO NOT store the pan resting on the drain.
- 4 Sweep the floor and remove all debris from pocket area, then position pan in pocket.
- Make sure floor drains properly by pouring water on it or checking it with a level. If in doubt, remove pan and review the previous steps.
- 6 Screw flanges to framing.
